

KAAWS Kitten Vaccination Schedule

6-8 Weeks	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Physical Exam2. FVRCP (Rhinitis, Calici and Panleukopenia)3. Intestinal Parasite Screening
9-11 Weeks	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Physical Exam2. FVRCP3. FeLV (Leukemia)
12-14 weeks	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Physical Exam2. FVRCP3. FeLV
14-16 Weeks	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Physical Exam2. Rabies3. FVRCP

*Boosters should be administered within 2-4 weeks apart. Otherwise vaccines would be voided.

*Any kitten vaccinated for the first time after 12 weeks requires at least two sets of FVRCP and FeLV regardless of age.

*Is recommended for all new kittens / cats to be tested or FeLV (Feline Leukemia) and FIV (Feline Immunodeficiency Virus)

*It is recommended for all kittens 8 weeks or older to be started on Heartworm/Flea and Tick Prevention.

Yearly Youth Fundamental Package - \$159

1. Physical Exam
2. Rabies
3. FVRCP
4. FeLV (optional)
5. Comprehensive Bloodwork (includes Heartworm and Intestinal Parasite Testing)
6. Nail Trim
7. 10% off additional services

*All vaccines are recommended yearly as listed above. (Unless otherwise specified by the veterinarian)

*We recommend all outdoor cats to be tested for FeLV and FIV yearly.
